Purpose of Role:

- To promote and develop eco-minded behaviour across the College
- Represent the College on environmental issues
- To be a role model to the rest of the school through their own actions in support of our shared environment
- To encourage greater participation and enjoyment for students of all ages
- Through their own passion and enthusiasm, motivate those around them
- Help to raise the awareness of, and celebrate, student success

Specific Responsibilities:

- Lead a team of students to manage and improve the College's environmental performance
- Organize weekly Eco Club activities
- Organise Eco rep termly meetings and contribute to the Student Council as required
- Contribute towards the annual action plan and travel plan
- Ensure the Eco-notice board is maintained
- Organise the House recycling competitions
- Organise an annual assembly
- Organise an annual beach clean
- Organise and manage the student litter teams
- Work with external partners in supporting our eco work
- Write a termly report for JCG Life, as directed by the teacher responsible for Eco
- Report on Eco activities in assemblies, as appropriate
- Any other duty as required by the teacher responsible for Eco

Person Specification:

Any student at JCG, irrespective of whether or not they have been part of the Eco Team, can apply for the role of Eco Captain. A student appointed to this position should demonstrate qualities of leadership and teamwork. She should be prepared to undertake specific duties on her own, be proactive in assuming responsibility and yet prepared to work as part of a team. She

should possess all those qualities as outlined for the Head Girl and work towards creating a positive, energetic and productive environment for all.
